Emmy-nominated **Brannon Braga** is currently Writer, Executive Producer, and Co-Creator of the drama series *Salem*. Braga was a key force as a Creator, Writer and Executive Producer of more than 300 episodes of the *Star Trek* series.

For over 13 years collectively, he worked on *The Next Generation*, *Voyager*, and *Enterprise*. His film credits include *Mission: Impossible II*, *Star Trek: Generations* and *Star Trek: First Contact*. Braga also served as Executive Producer and Director on FOX's re-launch of *COSMOS*, as Executive Producer and Writer on *Terra Nova*, Executive Producer and Writer on *24*, Creator and Executive Producer of *Flashforward*, and Writer and Executive Producer on *Threshold*.



Lisa Klink started her career writing for *Deep Space Nine* and *Voyager* before coming back to Earth for shows like *Martial Law* and *Missing*. She's also written two issues of *Batman* for DC Comics and contributed a short story to the anthology *Empower: Fight Like A Girl*. Lisa now writes novels, including three books in the *Dead Man* series and *All In*, co-authored with Joel Goldman. She's also a five-time champion on *Jeopardy!*

COLLOQUIUM HARASSMENT POLICY

A Celebration of *Star Trek* is dedicated to providing a harassment-free conference experience for everyone, regardless of gender, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, age, religion, or identity. This is in keeping with DePaul University's own Anti-Discrimination and Anti-Harassment policies. Joining together fan and scholar communities, this colloquium is intended to be open and welcoming to all. We do not tolerate harassment of conference participants in any form. Conference participants violating these rules may be sanctioned or expelled from the conference at the discretion of the conference organizers. Harassment includes offensive verbal comments, sexual images in public spaces, deliberate intimidation, stalking, following, harassing photography or recording, sustained disruption of talks or other events, inappropriate physical contact, and unwelcome sexual attention.
